Context:

Under the overall supervision of the Resource Management Officer (RMO) and guidance of the Common Services Assistant the successful incumbent will have to undertake the following duties and responsibilities.

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

1. Perform minor fixes within the building facilities such hydraulics, electrical and / carpenters works;
2. Perform checks in the control panels and electrical wiring and be able to identify any potential damages;
3. Repair any damages in relation to hydraulics;
4. Repair any minor damages in the offices wooden surfaces and/or walls;
5. Have knowledge and be able to install appliances and equipment;
6. Perform basic maintenance tasks such as replacing light bulbs etc.;
7. Check and identify potential troubleshooting to equipment and systems (e.g. ventilation);
8. Check functionality of safety systems (e.g. fire alarm);
9. Collaborate with workers and other professionals during renovations;
10. Report to the common services assistant any issues that he/she may identify;
11. Perform any other duties as may be assigned.

Required Qualifications and Experience

Education

- High School graduate with more than five years of relevant professional experience; degree from a technical college in a related field would be considered as an advantage.

Experience

- Previous related experience and solid technical knowledge in plumbing and electrical systems;
- Possess manual skills;
- Experience using hand and electrical tools;
- Experience working in international organizations, non-government or government institutions/organization in a multi cultural setting is an advantage;
- Demonstrated ability to work well under pressure and to keep deadlines;
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office environment.
