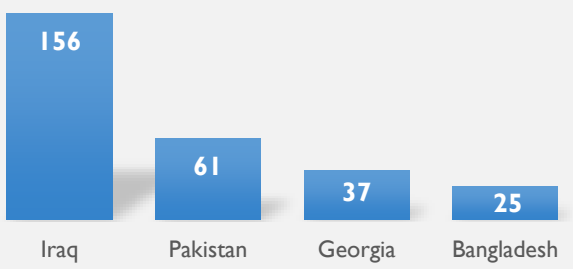

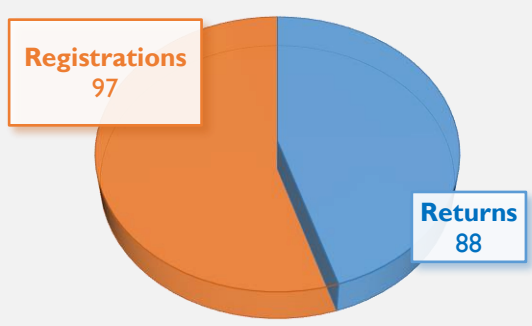

The project is co-funded 75% by European Funds (Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund) and 25% by National Funds



Under the framework of the project, IOM Greece organizes study visits to other IOM Offices in Europe as well as in third countries which have high experience in implementing AVRR projects. The purpose of the visits is to exchange information and best practices in the implementation of voluntary returns and reintegration.

On 13<sup>th</sup> July a delegation of IOM Mission in Greece, organized a three-day study visit in IOM premises in Islamabad, taking under consideration that Pakistani nationals is the top nationality of returns for the current AVRR project, as well as the yearly and close collaboration that exists with the IOM Office in Pakistan. Representatives of IOM Greece met with the Chief of IOM Mission in Pakistan, the National Operations Officer and operation and reintegration staff of IOM Pakistan.

All participants agreed that a great collaboration exists between the two missions and expressed their willingness to continue cooperate in order to support the return and reintegration of project beneficiaries. Furthermore, they all confirmed that they will work towards the enhancement of the cooperation and the acceleration of the exchange of information.
