EU Relocation Scheme

During October 2017, IOM Greece has helped 841 asylum seekers relocate safely from Greece to other EU member states. 356 were relocated to Germany, 231 to France and 94 to Switzerland. Read more

402 third country nationals returned to their home country with safety and dignity




During the reporting period, IOM Greece assisted 402 third country nationals to return to their home country. Amongst them, 162 were from Pakistan, 39 from Algeria, 49 from Georgia, 12 from Bangladesh and 36 from Iraq. Read more
