

Ensuring dignified living conditions for 19,000 beneficiaries

During the reporting period, IOM Greece was the official Site Management Support (SMS) agency in 24 facilities – 10 open accommodation sites and 14 hotels – ensuring dignified and harmonized accommodation and protection standards for 19,785 beneficiaries. For the school year 2017-2018, IOM ensured access to Greek schools for 2,760 migrant and refugee children accommodated in long-term accommodation sites. Temporary shelter and protection for 5,000 vulnerable migrants in Greece

IOM Greece, through [FILOXENIA](#) project provided dignified accommodation as well as basic assistance and protection services in accommodation facilities on the mainland to 5,447 refugees and migrants. During the reporting period and with the funding of [Directorate General Migration and Home Affairs of the European Commission \(DG HOME\)](#) 46 hotels operated in the Greek mainland.

1,500 vulnerable cases were hosted in OCAVRR



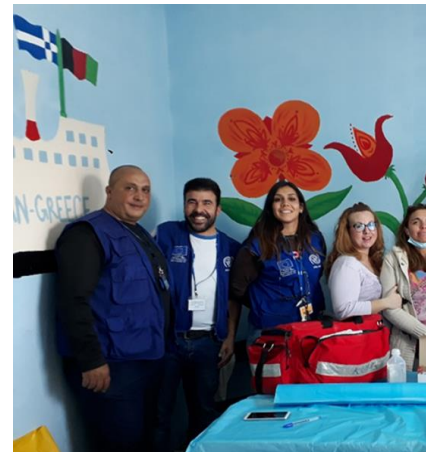
During the reporting period, Open Center for people registered for Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration project (OCAVRR) accommodated 1,637 vulnerable third country nationals. 1,485 returned voluntarily to their country of origin. Read more [here](#)



4,968 third country nationals returned to their home country with safety and dignity - 1,050 reintegration assistance plans were developed

During the reporting period, IOM assisted 4,968 third country nationals to return to their home country. Among them, 1,802 were from Iraq, 1,041 from Pakistan and 576 from Georgia. At the same time, 1,050 reintegration plans were developed. The clear majority were small businesses (749), following material assistance (146) and temporary accommodation (65). Read more [here](#).

15,000 migrants have received health mediation



Under [Re-Health](#) project, more than 30,000 migrants have been informed about the respective activities and E-PHR card. IOM Greece provided also hygiene kits, clothes and medical equipment to various spots both in the Greek mainland and on the islands of the North-eastern Aegean.



Provision of immediate accommodation to 1,330 UMCs

IOM provided safe accommodation to 1,339 unaccompanied children through the operation of 15 hotel facilities. 41% were from Afghanistan and 34% from Pakistan. Provision of psychosocial support to 4,000 beneficiaries



4,650 people on the islands of Lesbos and Samos received targeted cultural mediation services, under the funding of [KSRelief](#) a project addressed mostly to Syrian citizens, focusing also on the most vulnerable.



Provision of services to 600 UMCs on the islands



IOM ensured the provision of services to 664 unaccompanied minors residing on the islands of Lesbos and Chios. The activity is under [U-CARE project](#)

Emergency measures to enhance accommodation capacity and Site Management Support

IOM provided support to the Greek government in the emergency response to the increased migration flows and number of migrants and refugees in Greece through the enhancement of the accommodation capacity of four existing and new sites, while reconstruction and renovating works took place in five open accommodation facilities. As a result of the activity, a total of 3,100 beneficiaries received tailored services. [Read more here](#)
