Being the goods and services purchased and supplied within the Greek territory, we understand that VAT should apply. If this is the case, please advise how to proceed in order for us to purchase exclusive of VAT.

Question 4:

We see in the Instructions to Bidders, that the bids must be printed and delivered to IOM Office in Greece at Megalou Alexandrou 7, Argiroupoli, Athens, PC 16452 Greece, no later than 30 December 2021, 14:00 Hrs local time. Considering the imminent Christmas Holiday period and the Covid 19 pandemic which is affecting human mobility, could you please confirm if an electronic submission of the bids by email can be also considered? The original bid bond would be delivered with express courier to the above address and a scanned copy would be included in the bid submitted (electronically). Kindly advise.

Answer 4:

Submission via e-mail shall not be accepted. As per clause 20.1 of the bidding documents, bids along with the bidders' supporting documentation must be received by IOM at the address specified under ITB Clause 19.2.a - International Organization for Migration, 7 Megalou Alexandrou str., Argiroupoli 16452, Athens. In order to allow prospective bidders reasonable time in preparing their bids due to the holiday closure, IOM has extended the deadline for the submission of bids. Bids must be received by IOM at the address specified under ITB Clause 19.2.a no later than 10 January 2022, 12:00 PM (noon) local hrs. Please refer to Addendum No. 1 issued on 17/12/2021.

Question 5:

With reference to the Bid Security, please confirm that the bid security issued in May 2021 and submitted for the previous tender IFB Ref.no: 2021/MED/05/BR can be used and will be acceptable if provided with a specific Declaration/Addendum that states the bid security validity, the bid security amount and the amended IFB reference 2021/MED/05/BR v2 (Retendering). Please advise.

Answer 5:

Interested bidders are kindly requested to issue a new bid security with reference to the tender IFB No: 2021/MED/05/BRv2, pursuant to article 17 of the bidding documents. Furthermore, as per bidding documents pursuant to ITB Clause 10, the Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, a bid security in the amount 1.5% of the total bid amount.

Question 6:

Given the imminent Christmas closure of the suppliers and the limited time available before bid closure, the shipment of the samples might not be possible.

In the event our company would reconfirm the same models offered in the previous tender, for those items where the sending of samples is required, we kindly ask you to accept - and therefore consider valid for this tender - the samples previously sent and that are already in your hands. Please advise.

Answer 6:

As per clause 20.1 of the bidding documents, bids along with the bidders' supporting documentation must be received by IOM at the address specified under ITB Clause 19.2.a - International Organization for Migration, 7 Megalou Alexandrou str., Argiroupoli 16452, Athens.
