Temporary accommodation to more than 5,500 vulnerable population



"I want to convey messages through my creations: human dignity, freedom, living beings and nature", says Cedrick Diyavova. During the reporting period, IOM operated in 44 temporary accommodation facilities all over Greece providing accommodation services, psychosocial support, interpretation services and legal counselling to 5,551 vulnerable asylum seekers coming from the North Eastern Aegean islands.

Provision of a holistic network of services to 29 open accommodation facilities

During the reporting period 22,286 refugees and migrants were accommodated in open accommodation facilities in the mainland. Accommodation and services to 352 UMC

Under **PEDIA** project, during the reporting period, IOM provided accommodation and comprehensive services to 352 unaccompanied migrant children (UMC) currently living in 14 hotel facilities all over Greece. The majority of unaccompanied minors comes from Afghanistan (170) and Pakistan follows (90).

188 third-country nationals returned to their home country with safety and dignity

During the reporting period, IOM Greece assisted **188** third country nationals to return to their home country. Amongst them, 52 were from Iraq, 45 from Georgia, 18 from Pakistan and 18 form Iran. 134 were male, 39 female and 15 were children. IOM provided also tailored services to 17 returnees in situation of vulnerability. During the reporting period, IOM provided temporary accommodation in the Open Center to 143 applicants for voluntary return program. Among them 48, departed for their country of origin.



Enrollments in the #HELIOS project

4,451 beneficiaries enrolled in HELIOS project, while 205 beneficiaries received rental subsidies upon finding independent housing.
