The International Organization for Migration (IOM) is committed to the principle that humane and orderly migration benefits migrants and society. As the leading international organization for migration, IOM acts with its partners in the international community to: assist in meeting the growing operational challenges of migration management; advance understanding of migration issues; encourage social and economic development through migration, and; uphold the human dignity and well-being of migrants.

In Greece, IOM is focusing on responding to the Mediterranean migrant's crisis, in support of the Greek Government and in cooperation with all other agencies involved. IOM currently implements interventions within the areas of emergency, preparedness and response, disaster risk reduction, livelihoods, healthcare and psychosocial assistance, assisted voluntary return of migrants, migration and development, resettlement and repatriation, family reunification, counter human trafficking, assistance to vulnerable migrants.

Internal and external candidates are eligible to apply to this vacancy. For the purpose of the vacancy, internal candidates are considered as first-tier candidates.

Context:

In the framework of the situation regarding the migrants, asylum seekers and refugees across Greece, IOM Greece is establishing a pool of candidates interested to join the organization as soon as possible. The action under which the candidates will be selected shall contribute to the provision of targeted care interventions to the unaccompanied children (UMC) residing in Greece. Therefore, IOM will capitalize on its extensive experience on the areas of child protection so as to provide tailored support and interventions to the UMC by offering accommodation and care services.

Under the overall supervision of the Senior Programme Coordinator/Field Office Coordinator and the direct supervision of the Facility Coordinator, the successful candidate will provide support in implementing project activities related to the provision of medical services for UMCs in the assigned accommodation facility.

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

1. Perform daily nursing activities in the assigned accommodation facility in the areas of:
 - a. Medical examinations,
 - i. Such as checking vital signs, weight, height, visual acuity;
 - ii. Blood, urine or sputum collection as required;
 - b. Imaging;

- c. Laboratory testing;
 - d. Vaccinations;
 - e. TB management;
 - f. Treatment and referrals;
 - g. Pre-departure procedures and medical movements;
 - h. Documentation, certification and information transmission; and,
 - i. Other technical areas as may be required.
2. Provide information and detailed explanations to the migrants and/or refugees in relation to:
 - The migration health assessment process; and,
 - Treatments and referrals.
 3. Ensure proper identification and follow-up by:
 - Comprehensive history taking;
 - Accurate and thorough Biodata collection;
 - Ensuring ID verification for each step of the health assessment process; and,
 - Keeping a register of applicants who undergo health investigations and testing.
 4. Verify samples of sputum, blood or others are properly transported to the laboratory or previously designated location.
 5. Maintain and monitor the pharmacy, stock, medical kits, and emergency kits and for medical escorts if applicable.
 6. Provide pre and/or post counselling to migrants or refugees on TB or HIV education, prevention, and management as appropriate.
 7. Prepare administrative reports and program updates as necessary.
 8. Support the planning and execution of mobile missions if applicable.
 9. Maintain collaborative relationships with various partners to facilitate the follow up and relevant information sharing. Partners include internal IOM departments, other health providers other UN agencies or NGO's and others as applicable.
 10. Collect statistical information and share with the MHO as per present and agreed upon format.
 11. Perform such other duties as may be assigned.

Required Qualifications and Experience

Education

- Bachelor's Degree in Nursing with a minimum of one year relevant clinical experience; and valid license to practice nursing in Greece.
- Secondary School Diploma with at least three years of relevant working experience in UMC facilities.

Experience and Skills

- Previous experience in a similar role preferred, previous experience at an IOM Emergency Accommodation Facility will be considered an asset.
- Excellent technical skills, including in phlebotomy;
- Training or working experience in the areas of Tuberculosis management, mass immunizations, communicable diseases, laboratory testing or public health is an advantage;
- Computer literacy required: MS Office suite (Word, Excel, Access).

Languages

Fluency in **English** and **Greek** (written and oral) is required.
