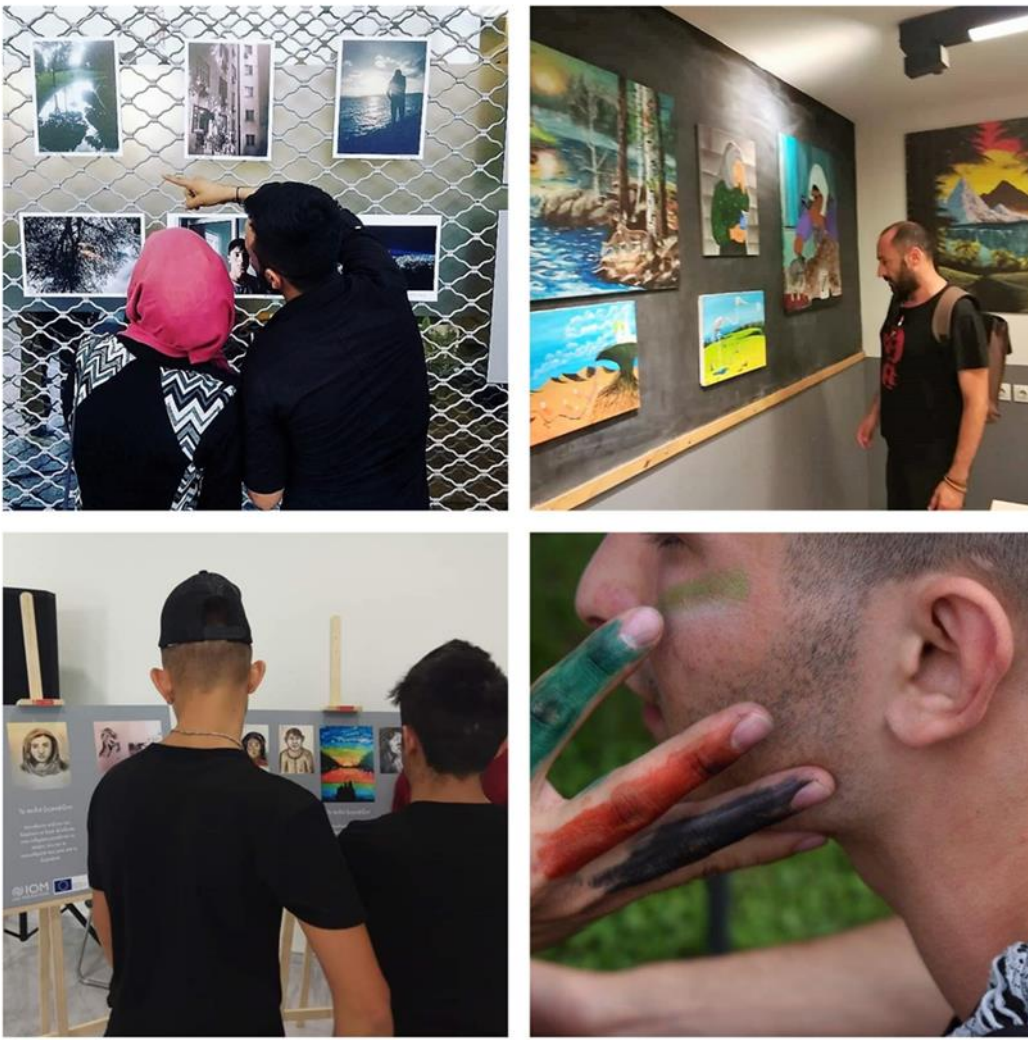


IOM celebrates World Refugee Day

During the reporting period, IOM provided accommodation to 587 unaccompanied children in 17 hotel facilities all over Greece. Through [PEDIA project](#), IOM is taking urgent actions to ensure that migrant/refugee children in need, are immediately placed in a protective environment and receive tailored services.
