Temporary accommodation to 4,280 vulnerable population

Koffi Drafor and Koffi Amouzou have been living for the last months in temporary accommodation facilities in Athens, under [FILOXENIA](#) project. During the reporting period, IOM operated in 35 temporary accommodation facilities all over Greece providing accommodation services, psychosocial support, interpretation services and legal counselling to 4,287 vulnerable asylum seekers coming from the North Eastern Aegean islands.

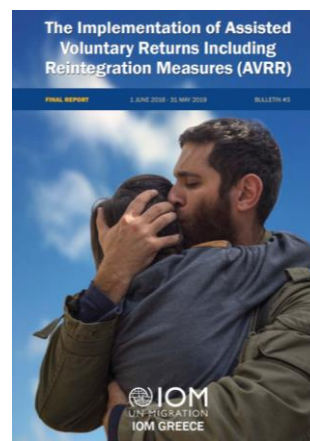
Provision of health services

With the voluntary contribution of Kavala Hospital, 117 minors, aging from 12 months to 15 years of age, were vaccinated, many of whom would otherwise could not be allowed to attend the Greek educational system and go to school due to lack of the necessary shots. Medical services are provided under IOM project "Improving the Greek Reception System through Site Management Support and Targeted Interventions in Long-Term Accommodation Sites".
