The tender constitutes four separate lots. Interested bidders may submit bid for one (1) or more lots. The evaluation and award of contract will be conducted per lot and is subject to funds availability.

Bids must be delivered by hand or through courier mail to IOM Office in Greece, 7 Meg. Alexandrou str, 16452 Argiroupoli, Attica **on or before 26th January 2021 at 14:00 hrs.** No late proposal shall be accepted. Late bids shall be rejected.

Bids shall remain valid for ninety (90) days after the submission date of bids and shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount not less than 2% of the total net bid amount in the form of a bank guarantee, bank draft, letter of credit, or a certified check from a reputable banking institution.

Bidding procedure will be conducted based on the rules of the International Organization for Migration.

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.
