Bids must be delivered by hand or through courier mail to IOM Office in Greece, 7 Meg. Alexandrou str, 16452 Argyroupoli, Attica **on or before 11th February 2021 at 13:00 hrs**. No late proposal shall be accepted. Late bids shall be rejected.

Bids shall remain valid for ninety (90) days after the submission date of bids and shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount not less than 2,5% of the total bid amount in the form of a bank guarantee, bank draft, letter of credit, or a certified check from a reputable banking institution.

Bidding procedure will be conducted based on the rules of the International Organization for Migration.

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.
